

**TEMUR PREFABRICATED
MEMBER INTERVIEW
(30.07.2021)**



Can we get to know you?

My name is Adem Temür. I was born and raised in Zile. I completed my primary and secondary education in Zile. Then my brothers and I started to work in the prefabricated sector. When we thought we had reached sufficient maturity, we turned to the idea of starting our own business. Since 2014, together with my brothers, we have been in the prefabricated building sector, at the beginning of our own business. At first; In our process, which started as a buy and sell, we entered the manufacturing sector with the recognition of our company and our products. Currently in our region; Although there are companies in which we operate in the same sector, we are the only company that is a manufacturer.

Our head office is in Zile and we also have a branch in Amasya Merzifon.

Can we get to know your company?

It has been about 7 years since the first establishment of our company. In the past 7 years; we have invested in our industry, our business and our products. We send products to many points of Turkey, mainly in the Black Sea Region. This year, we are also negotiating for export.

Although our main production process is prefabricated manufacturing, we also invested in new machinery this year.



With the new sheet bending machine we purchased, we were able to produce longer-lasting products and reduce our sheet wastage during manufacturing by eliminating the parts putting and welding processes in prefabricated building production. In addition, we started to perform sheet metal bending operations for foreign companies.



How do you see the future of your industry?

The Covid-19 epidemic, which affected the whole world, increased the interest in “modular” structures, which are completed by combining parts and can be disassembled again if necessary. In 2021, which was under the influence of the epidemic, there was a 40 percent increase in the demand for modular structures. It is predicted that the market size of the sector will reach 106.22 billion dollars by 2027 with this acceleration.



What do you think about the activities of Zile CCI?

Our Chamber of Commerce and Industry has always been with us since the first day we registered. We are very pleased with the work of our Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the support it provides to us.
